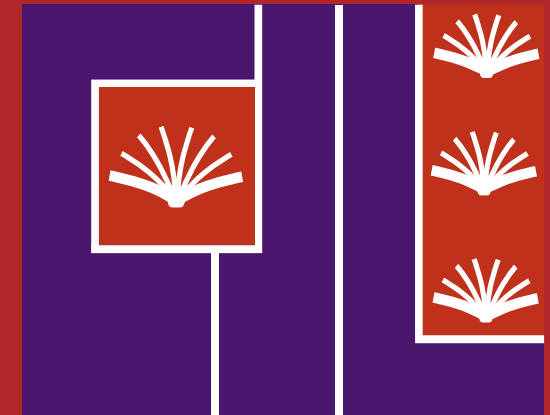

Accomplishments of 2004

- 148,200 people carried Genesee District Library cards on December 31, 2004.
- 41.54% more items were checked out in 2004 than in 2003.
- Millennium Silver, GDL's new web-based automated circulation system, was installed in November.
- Morning and Sunday hours were increased for several branches.
- Customer service surveys were conducted. As a result there were changes in hours and new services were added.
- 3,653 kids participated in Summer Reading 2004.
- Famous authors visited Genesee District Library in 2004 for the first time. The library hosted the internationally acclaimed best selling author, Ken Follett, in December. Over 500 people attended the free program. Best selling mystery author Harlan Coben presented a spring program for 300 people.
- GDL was the first library to receive the Library of Michigan's Quality Service Audit Checklist—Essential Level.

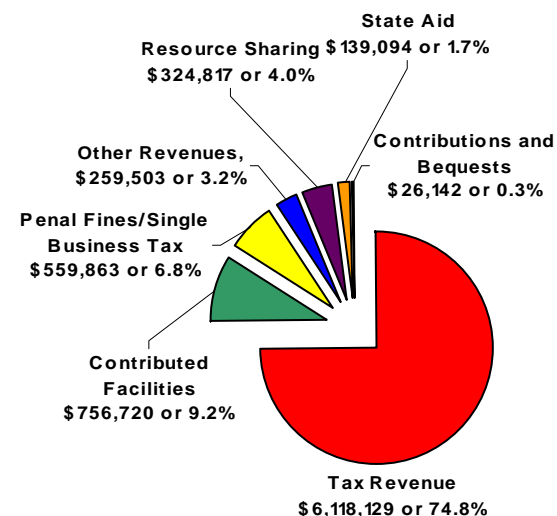
