### **Center for Higher Education Achievement**

The Center of Higher Education Achievement offers three programs for adults 25 and older:

- The Adult Basic Reading and Math program, focusing on adults at a K-5<sup>th</sup> grade level in either area. This is a one-on-one experience, where students are paired up with a tutor.
- The Pre-GRE program, which reintroduces Middle School (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade level) academic concepts to those who missed or forgot these course subjects.
- The GED Program, a small group course which prepares students for the computer base GED exam. All coursework is aligned to the Common Core Standards.
- Additionally, there is the English as a Second Language program, a one-on-one program allowing non-native English speakers to gain basic English reading, writing, math, and speaking skills.
