About the **Genesee District Library**

The Genesee District Library (GDL) is a public library system serving the residents of Genesee County, Michigan. Our service area covers all communities within the county with the exception of the City of Flint, which is served by the Flint Public Library.

The GDL system consists of 19 locations, and includes services such as the Robert T. Bolo Business Center (Grand Blanc-McFarlen), the Talking Book Center and Homebound Service (Headquarters), and three seed libraries (Fenton-Winegarden, Forest Township, Montrose-Jennings).

In a normal year, over one million visits are made annually to the GDL for books, movies, music, technology and programs. Residents within our service area also have online access to books and music.

The GDL was formed on January 1, 1980 through a partnership between Genesee County and Grand Blanc Township. It is governed by an eightmember volunteer board. Funding is provided through a .9981 county-wide millage (excluding the City of Flint). The millage was renewed in August of 2016 by a 3-to-1 margin. The remaining revenue comes from fees and fines, state aid, grants and gifts.

Black History Celebration

The 21st Annual Black History Month Brunch was cancelled for 2022 due to the pandemic. Instead, Genesee District Library partnered with ABC12 to produce the 21st Annual Black History Celebration which aired on Thursday, February 24 at 7:30 p.m. on ABC12. Though the Brunch typically hosts 400–500 guests, this televised program reached 29,131 households. Host Matt Franklin emceed the virtual event. Awards of Excellence were presented to April Cook-Hawkins, Danielle Green, and Lisa Horne. The Partner in Progress Award was presented to the Sarvis Park Neighborhood Organization led by Ladel Lewis. Four Washington performed three original songs.


Reading Challenges

The Oceans of Possibilities Summer Reading Challenge ran from June 11 to August 6. There were 183 total prizes given away in prize drawings and 965 books given away for completions. In addition to the Summer Reading Challenge, GDL held a reading challenge in September to celebrate National Library Card Signup Month, a Winter Reading Challenge, and a March is Reading Month Challenge.

National Library Card Signup Month

In 1987, Secretary of Education William Bennett stated: "Let's have a campaign ... Every child should obtain a library card and use it." In that spirit, GDL once again promoted a September campaign to encourage library card signups:

- 1. Reached out to all Genesee County schools to assist them in obtaining cards for all of their students.
- 2. Offered a free GDL cloth tote bag, lunch bag or ball cap to anyone who came into the branch to sign up for a card between September 1–30.
- 3. Entered those people in a drawing to win an Apple iPad.




