- The Adult Basic Reading and Math program, focusing on adults at a K-5th grade level in either area. This is a one-on-one experience, where students are paired up with a tutor.
- The Pre-GED program, which reintroduces Middle School (6th-8th grade level) academic concepts to those who missed or forgot these course subjects.
- The GED Program, a small group course which prepares students for the computer base GED exam. All coursework is aligned to the Common Core Standards.
- English as a Second Language (ESL – Level 2)
- Financial Literacy Classes covering basic banking, understanding credit, budgeting and planning and homeownership.
- Civil Legal Counseling covering evictions, family law, tenant rights, elder law and more
- Job Readiness Training
