At the Day Center, families can shower, do laundry, have access to phones and computers, take part in life-skills courses, and have transportation to school for children. The host churches provide meals, and individual rooms for each family, with a bed for each family member. Guest families are not required to have a faith/religious affiliation.

### **REACH, Traverse Place & Street Outreach –Genesee County Youth Corps**

Genesee County Youth Corps offers three programs addressing homelessness:

**REACH** is for youths aged 10 through 17, and provides free shelter and comfortable living for up to 21 days. Parental consent must be given, and the youth has the choice to stay or not. Free counseling services are provided for up to 90 days, for all youths, sheltered or not.

The Genesee County Government works with banks to provide a no-interest loan up to \$5,000 for first time home buyers who reside in Genesee County, outside of the City of Flint. Income must be below 80% of the median Genesee County income.
